Planes, Trains, and Castles: Troop 21 Europe Trip July 18 - August 2, 2026

## **Tentative Itinerary**

- **July 18:** Overnight flight to Munich. Catch some zzz's as we'll hit the ground running tomorrow morning.
- July 19: Welcome to Germany! After dropping off our bags at our <u>hostel</u>, we'll visit the <u>Nymphenburg Palace Complex</u> and the <u>Alte Pinakothek</u>. Then, we'll wander around Munich's city center.
- **July 20:** Today, we'll explore <u>The Residence Museum + Treasury + Cuvilliés</u> <u>Theatre</u>, then the <u>BMW-Welt and Museum</u>.
- **July 21:** Take a leisurely and luxurious <u>bus</u> tour of *The King's Castles* (Neuschwanstein and Linderhof).
- **July 22:** After breakfast, board a train bound for Vienna, Austria. Check in to our <u>hostel</u> and explore the city with stops at the <u>Kaisergruft</u> and <u>St.</u> Stephen's Cathedral.
- July 23: Warm up your vocal chords as today we'll explore <u>Vienna's State</u>
   Opera House before seeing the exquisite <u>Hofburg Palace Imperial</u>

  Apartments and <u>Treasury</u>.
- **July 24:** You want more palaces? Well, you're in luck: today, we'll explore the <u>Schönbrunn Palace</u> and <u>Belvedere Palace</u>.
- **July 25**: "Auf Wiedersehen!" to Vienna and "Ahoj!" to Prague. Go straight to our <a href="hostel">hostel</a> and walk the Old Town/Charles Bridge and tour the <a href="hunicipal House">Municipal House</a>.

- **July 26:** Castles in the Czech Republic!?! Today, we'll explore the <u>Prague Castle</u>, <u>Lobkowicz Palace</u>, <u>Cold War Museum</u>, and the Jewish Quarter.
- July 27: Explore the Castle Quarter and Lesser Town (<u>Loreta Church</u>, <u>Strahov Monastery</u>, Nerudova St., Lesser Town Square, and the Lennon Wall), Kampa Island, Wenceslas Square, and the <u>Mucha Museum</u>.
- July 28: In the AM, we'll take a train back West to Nürnberg. Drop our bags at the <u>hostel</u> and walk the Old Town with stops at <u>St. Lawrence</u> <u>Church</u>, the <u>City Museum</u>, <u>Imperial Castle</u>, <u>Historic Art Bunker</u>, and the <u>Albrecht Dürer House</u>.
- July 29: Explore the <u>Germanic National Museum</u> in the AM. In the afternoon, your choice of the <u>DB Railway Museum</u> or the <u>Nazi Documentation Center & Rally Grounds</u> and the <u>Nürnberg Trials</u> Courtroom and Museum.
- July 30: Early AM train to Rothenburg ob der Tauber. After getting sorted at our <a href="hostel">hostel</a>, choose what you'd like to do within a small group: Rothenburg Town Walk (Walk the wall, <a href="Historical Town Hall Vaults">Historical Town Hall Vaults</a>, <a href="Mistorical Town Hall Vaults">St.</a>
   <a href="Jakob's Church">Jakob's Church</a>, <a href="Rothenburg Museum">Rothenburg Museum</a>), <a href="Town Hall Tower">Town Hall Tower</a>, or the <a href="Medieval Crime and Punishment Museum</a>. Experience the <a href="Might Watchman's Tour">Night Watchman's Tour</a> in the evening.
- **July 31:** Another early train to Stuttgart. Quickly drop off our bags at the hostel and explore the Mercedes-Benz Museum and Porsche Museum.
- August 1: Leisurely train back to Munich. Check in to the <u>hostel</u> and see the <u>Deutsches Museum</u>. Celebrate our final night with an unforgettable experience at the <u>Hofbräuhaus</u>
- August 2: Homeward bound.
