




## Troop 21 Philmont 2027!

July 17 – August 1, 2027 (approx.)



### We got two Philmont crews for 2027! It's time to get ready...

Troop 21 has been lucky enough to get two crews through the annual Philmont Scout Ranch lottery. We will leave for Philmont on or about Saturday, July 17, 2027, and return on or about Saturday, August 1, 2027. Exact departure/return times to be determined by our travel plans depending on what transportation method decide. SPACE IS LIMITED! If you want the opportunity to attend the ultimate Boy Scout High Adventure Camp experience pay your deposit ASAP.

### ACTION LIST:

- **Important:** In order for us to confirm our spot, Troop 21 must send our initial deposit to Philmont no later than November 28, 2025. Therefore, we need your commitment and deposit ASAP!
- Ensure Tom Coscia has your deposit of **\$200** per person (made out to Troop 21) by **November 21, 2025**, to reserve your spot. Remember, space is limited! You can pay the deposit via the Troop website or Venmo, or mail your deposit to 647A Sugar Trail Court, St. Peters, MO 63376.
- Start training! A great place to start is the November 8, 2025 Taum Sauk Mountain Backpacking trip.

- Where is Philmont? [Philmont Scout Ranch](#) covers 140,177 acres in northern New Mexico on the eastern slope of the Sangre De Cristo mountains near the town of Cimmaron. The ranch lies between 6,500 and 12,441 feet above sea level.
- Who can attend? Philmont trek participants need to be 14 years old OR 13 years old and completed 8th grade by 7/20/2027. Also, Philmont is a "Team Sport" and your commitment to work together as a crew and the "Scouting way" is critical. Therefore, preference will be given to Scouts of First Class rank or higher. - Philmont is 100% scout led. That means adults that attend will be advising only and youth will lead these treks. Each crew will select a crew leader, a crew chaplain's aid, and a crew wilderness guide.
- How many are in a crew? Each crew has between 7 and 12 members, including 2 to 4 adults.
- What kind of training will there be? The crews will plan several one day and overnight hikes/backpacking campouts to begin in the fall of 2026.
- How much does it cost? We are budgeting \$2,400 for the complete package that includes: your 14-day Philmont fees (\$1,675), round trip transportation, food, fees for the training events (day hikes & campouts) and trek t-shirts.
